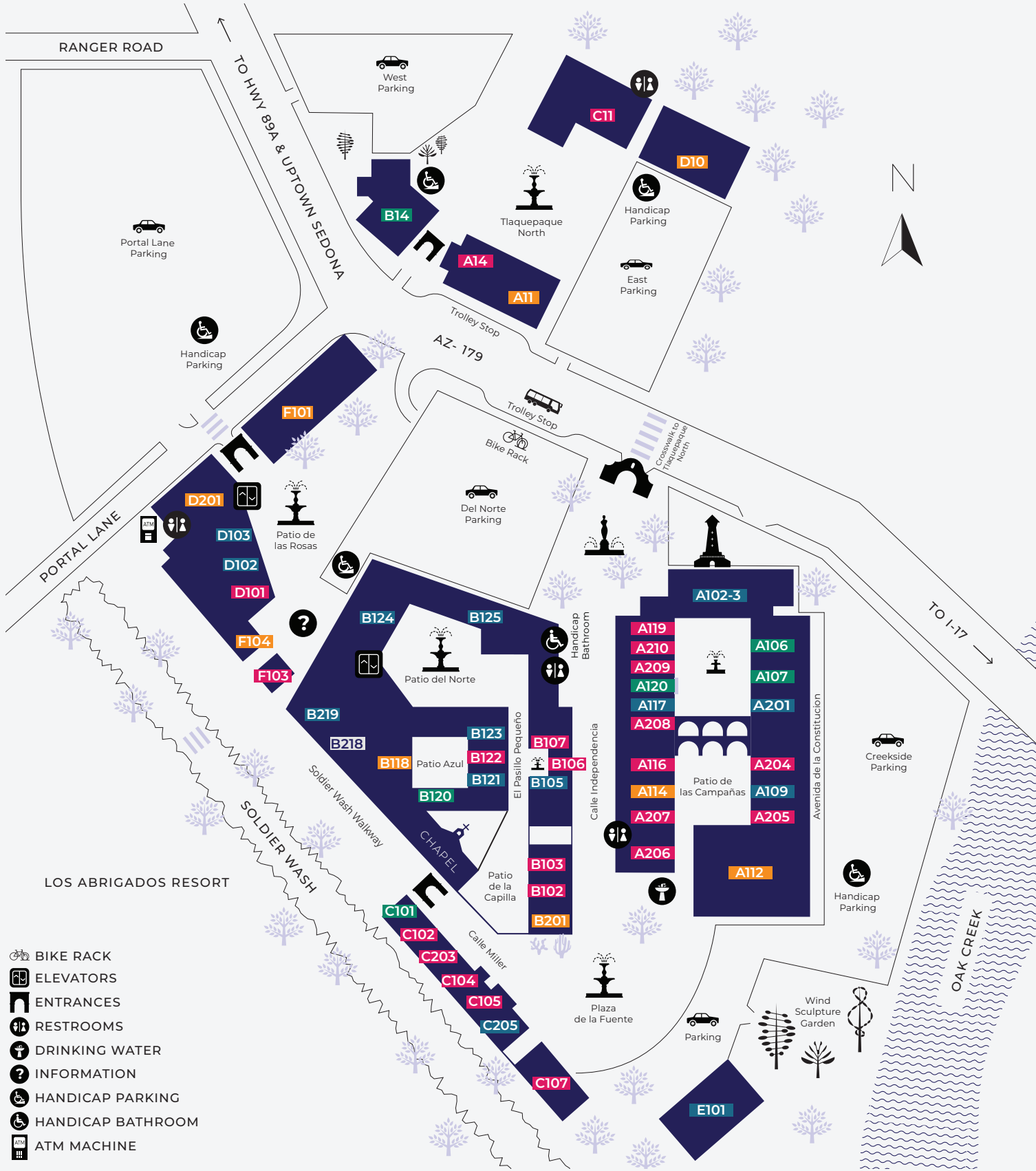
A landmark since 1973, Tlaquepaque, which means the “best of everything,” offers a unique art and shopping experience in the heart of Sedona.
